Submission Guidelines:

- **Language:** Articles may be submitted in Uzbek, Russian, or English, with a minimum length of 6 pages.

- **Formatting:** Articles must be well-edited and thematically aligned, submitted in A4 format with 1.5 line spacing and margins as follows: top and bottom - 2.5 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm. Only electronic submissions will be accepted.

- **File Specifications:** Submissions must be in Microsoft Word format, using Times New Roman font, size 12. Pages should not be numbered.

- **Title and Author Information:** the title of the article should be written in capital letters, followed by the first and last name(s) of the author(s), the institution name, and the e-mail address of the corresponding author. A list of references must be provided at the end of the article. The authors bear full responsibility for the accuracy and reliability of the data and facts presented in the manuscript.

- **File Naming:** The file name should include the author's last name and institution (e.g., "B.Abdullayev NUUz" for an author from the National University of Uzbekistan).

- **Abstract and Keywords:** An abstract and keywords must be provided in Uzbek, Russian, and English.

Conference materials will be published in electronic format on the website ecoilm.uz and distributed to authors. Selected articles prepared in English will be published in a Scopus-indexed journal and in a special issue of the "Ecological herald of Uzbekistan".

Conference Dates: December 19-20, 2025. Both in-person and virtual attendance options are available.
